GRAMMAR SECTION

NOUN: A noun is a naming word. It can name anything, a person, animal, place, thing, quality, state, idea, etc.

Example- boy, girl , Aditya , shailini , angry ,rabbit, honesty, laughter, are all nouns.

Kinds of nouns: Nouns are of four kinds:

- a. **Proper nouns:** A proper noun is the name of a particular person or thing.

Example- Taj Mahal, Mt. Everest, Kaveri, Sachin etc.

All proper nouns begin with capital letter.

- b. **Common nouns**

A common noun is a name shared by every person or thing of the same class. It does not refer to any particular person or thing.

Example : man, woman, tiger, hill, table, etc.

c. Collective nouns:

A collective noun is the name of a group of people or collection of things of the same kind:

Example : class, team, army, swarm, bundle, bunch etc.

d. Abstract nouns:

An abstract noun is the name of a quality, state or idea.

Example : beauty, wisdom, childhood, thickness etc.



Lesson1: Looking Back

Topics :

- **Expanded form and short form**

Expanded form: It is the way of writing numbers to see the math value of individual digits.

Example: $3256 = 3000 + 200 + 50 + 6$ OR $3 \text{ Th} + 2 \text{ H} + 5 \text{ T} + 6 \text{ O}$

Short form: When we write a number using digits, the number is said to be in short form.

Example: $4000 + 700 + 30 + 3 = 4733$

- **Comparison of numbers**

Examples: $4532 > 3211$

$8290 < 1426$

$5643 = 5643$

- **Ascending and descending order**

Ascending order: Arranging of numbers from smaller to bigger.

Examples: $3265 < 4320 < 4678 < 7645$.

Descending order: Arranging of numbers from bigger to smaller.

Examples: $8756 < 5632 < 4112 < 2341$

- **Successor and predecessor**

Successor and predecessor refer to the numbers directly after or directly before the given number, respectively.

To find the successor of a given whole number, add one to the given number and for predecessor subtract one from the given number.

Example: Successor of 2360 is 2361 and predecessor of 5498 is 5497.

Topic – Weather and Season

WEATHER

The conditions in the air above the earth such as wind, rain, or temperature, especially at a particular time over a particular area are called weather.

Weather changes from day to day and from time to time. Sometimes it is hot and sometimes it is cold. One some days it rains while on some days it is dry and windy.

Hot days – Some days of the year are very hot. Sun shines brightly on hot days. People like to sit under the fans or air conditioners and cooler to keep them cool. We like to wear cotton clothes to keep our bodies cool on hot days and like to have cold drinks , ice-creams etc.

Cold days – some days of the year are very cold. During these days, it snows at some places. People wear woolen clothes to keep them warm. We like to have tea or coffee on cold days. We use heaters to keep our rooms warm and sit near the fire or under the sun to keep warm.

Windy days - On some days of the year, the wind blows very fast. When air moves fast, it is called wind. Strong winds can blow away things to distant places. When air blows very fast, it is also called a storm.

Rainy days – On some days of the year, it rains heavily. During these days, sky is covered with clouds, the weather is also moist and wet. Children enjoy playing in the rain. We use umbrella and raincoats to protect ourselves from the rain. Sometimes, a rainbow is seen in the sky on a rainy day.

SEASONS

Depending upon weather, there are five different seasons.

The five seasons are:

1. Winter season
2. Spring season
3. Summer season
4. Rainy season
5. Autumn season
